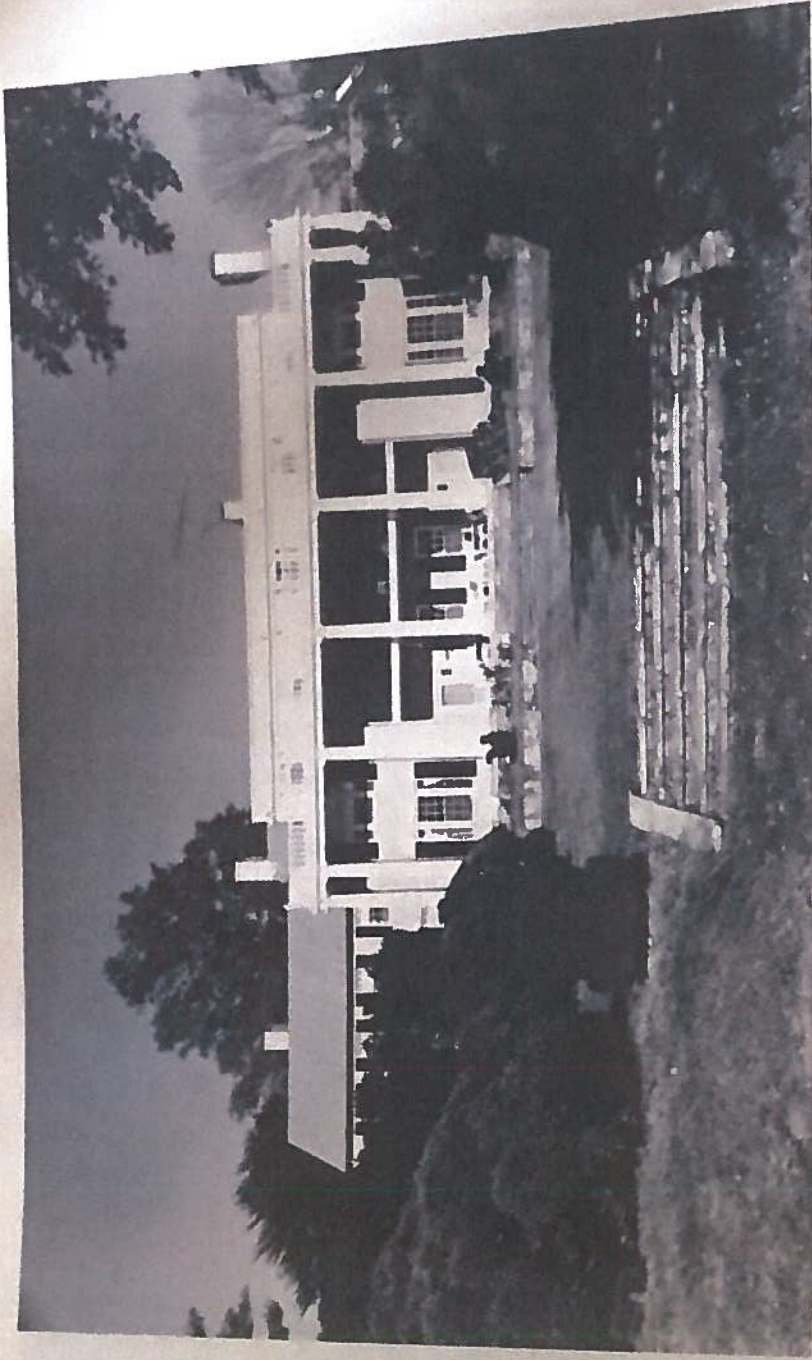


# Catesby



In the 1700's Daniel French purchased the land on which Catesby was built. His daughter, Elizabeth French married Benjamin Tasker Dulany, a colonel and aide to George Washington in 1773. Their son, John Peyton Dulany, became owner in 1815. He married Mary Ann DeButts and they built Old Wellbourne.

Their daughter, Julia Anne Bladen Dulany, married Samuel DeButts and they lived at The

Anchorage. The Anchorage was later owned by Mrs. Mary Dulany Neville. Her niece, Neville Atkinson, lived there for a number of years.

The Anchorage was renamed Catesby when it was purchased by Mr. Alex Humphrey with the "purchase" provided him by his fine steeplechase horse, "Sir Catesby."

Catesby is now the home of Mr. and Mrs. Bahman Batmangheldj.
